Curriculum enhancement days are a part of school life at King Edward VI School. These days create flexibility for us to look at activities and ideas without interrupting core learning.

For the next Curriculum Enhancement Day on Monday 5th October, Year 7 History pupils are being given the opportunity to visit the Warwick Castle to supplement their understanding of Medieval Times we will be studying this year. We shall be leaving school around 9.00am and returning at 3.30pm in time for normal school transport arrangements. I would like to see all pupils participate as this is a great opportunity to see how castles' developed and what life would have been like in this period.

Pupils will not be required to wear school uniform on the day and they need to bring a packed lunch with them. We are able to offer this trip with a voluntary contribution of £18.00 per student for coach travel, activities at the castle and insurance. The charge to students is a contribution towards the full cost of the activity. As this visit takes place during the school day this is a voluntary contribution. No student will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay or do not pay in full. However, the visit will not be able to go ahead if the school does not receive sufficient parental contributions by 25th September.
