We have organised a performance of 'An Inspector Calls' by 'SayTwo' Theatre Company. This will then be followed by activities where the actors will explore the themes and characters of the play and students will be invited to pose questions to the characters about their motivation and why they behave the way they do in the play. This is particularly useful as it will provide information for our Year 10 students as they prepare to study the play for their English Literature GCSE.

'SayTwo' are one of the UK's best-loved educational touring theatre companies. They are passionate that every person in society has the right to access and enjoy theatre in a fun, informative and inclusive environment, and we are very much looking forward to their creative version of this fantastic play. The performance will take place in Bader Hall in the afternoon.

They will be looking at self-esteem, self-confidence and the impact of reading to support this. Students will take part in this presentation in the morning and have a chance to reflect on this with their form teachers.
