

RE: Year 11 Spring Report 2023



Your child's Report for the spring term is now available on the GO 4 Schools (GO) website*. Unfortunately, this information is not accessible via the GO app. It sits alongside the attendance, behaviour, and timetable information already available on the website and is accessed via the icons as shown on the left-hand side of this letter. To access the Report online, select the 'Reports' icon and then the icon for the latest Report.

This is an opportunity to indicate how your child is progressing in the final stages of their GCSE studies and their general approach to work. Following the school's Code of Conduct, teachers have rated students using the scale 'always', 'usually', 'sometimes', 'rarely', or 'never' in relation to whether they are **ready** to learn, show **respect** and **strive** to do their best in lessons. There is also a comment for each subject.

In this Report you will see that in addition to the 'target grade' there a 'projected grade', this is based on their teacher's professional judgement and is the grade that they are likely to achieve in their final examination. The 'progress indicator' is a comparison between the 'projected grade' and the 'target grade'.

For target setting, we use estimation data generated by Fischer Family Trust (FFT), which is an independent non-profit organisation that is used extensively by Ofsted. Fischer Family Trust looks at how students with a similar prior attainment profile (i.e. Key Stage 2 test scores) have performed over the last few years in the GCSE/Key Stage 4 examinations and estimates the percentage chance of gaining a particular grade. In order to challenge students, their 'target grade' is set at an aspirational 20%, with many of our students achieving even higher than their target. It is important to note that progress is often made at different rates in each subject.
