Dear Parents and and carers,

Following the guidance from the Department for Education, I am writing to share an initial outline of our provision for Year 12 students which will take place this term from 15th June onwards. Home learning is expected to remain the predominant mode of education but we are able to offer face-to face contact in school for up to 25% of the year group at any one time. Home Learning for all students, including Year 12, will continue via Show My Homework during this half-term.

It is hoped that each Year 12 student will have the opportunity to have up to three 2 hour sessions with each of their subjects over a period of three weeks. This is likely to be for 3 weeks from Mon 22nd June through to Friday 10th July.

The 2 hours session will take place on the day that students would normally have their morning session. As we will be splitting the majority of the groups, students will be in for either the morning or the afternoon of their particular day.

- Option Block A will be Monday am & pm
- Option Block B will be Wednesday am & pm
- Option Block C will be Tuesday am & pm
- Option Block D will be Friday am & pm
- Option Block E will be Thursday am & pm

You will receive by post a timetable showing subjects, rooms and timings. It is essential that students bring a copy (on paper or on their phone) as they will be expected to follow it precisely. The safety of students and staff is paramount; the letter will also set out very clear expectations for how this provision will work.

Sessions will have staggered start and finish times and students will be in small groups. They will need to come into school and go directly to their assigned room, there will be no capacity for early arrivals waiting around in buildings. There is no capacity for changes to groups or timings. The staggered start and finish times should also allow students to use public transport at quieter times where required.

We hope that having students in school will give them a chance to talk and share how they have been feeling as well as how they have been managing the workload of home learning. The sessions themselves will aim to:

- Clarify any issues with the remote learning so far, discussing issues or challenges with the work that has been set.
- Prepare students for Year 13 learning
- Set out any future home learning and giving students the tools to tackle the work set



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We understand that parents and students may be nervous about a return to school. It is a family decision as to whether your child attends the sessions offered to them. However, I would urge you to wait to receive the personalised timetable and further information before taking any decision to keep them at home. Safety will be paramount for everyone. If, however, you are certain that your child will not be attending any in-school sessions before the end of term then please email attendance@kingedwardvi-lichfield.staffs.sch.uk including your child's name, tutor group and the reason why you do not wish them to attend school.

We will be sending an individual timetable for your child by post in the coming week. Some parents and students will be contacted directly about provision during the week beginning 15th June but for **most Year 12 students they will be coming in to school from the week beginning Monday 22nd June.**
